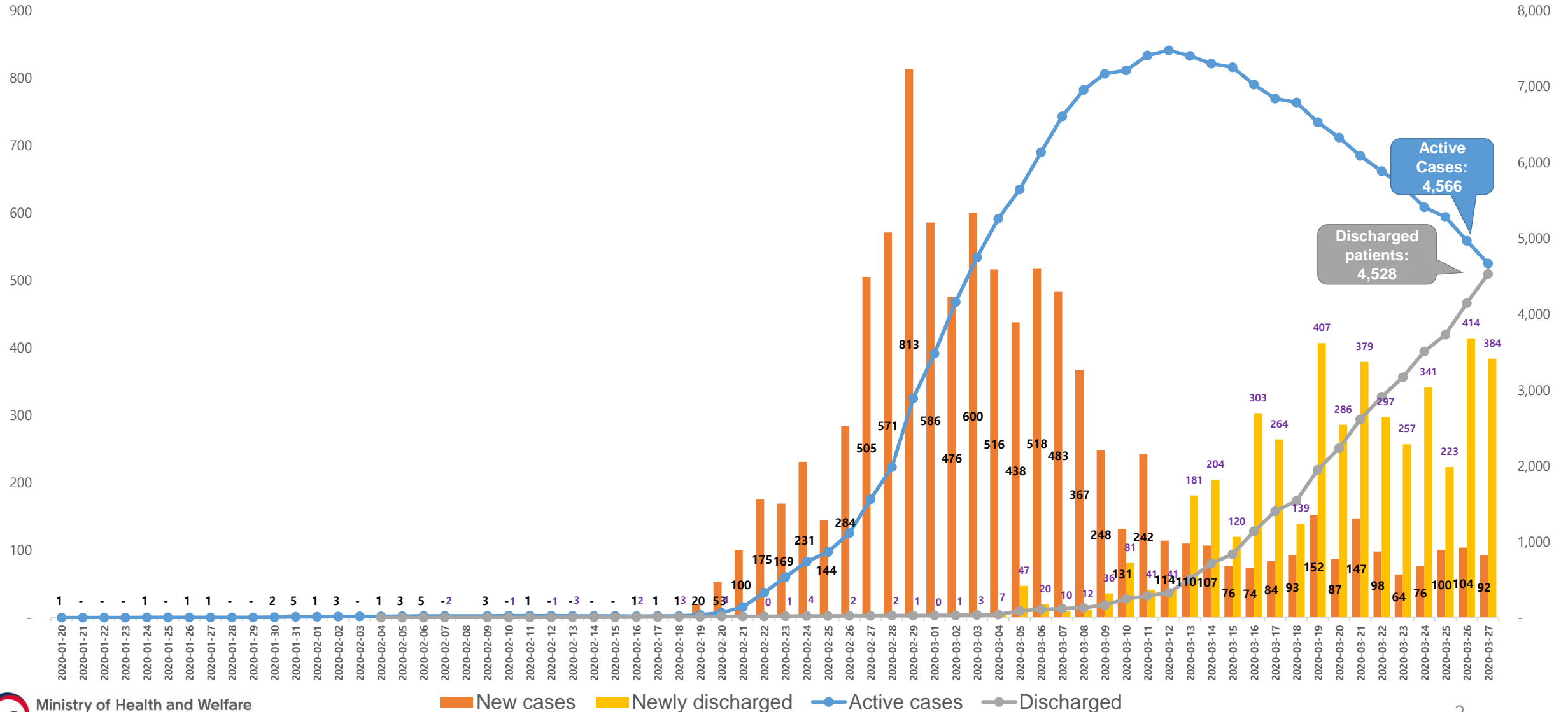




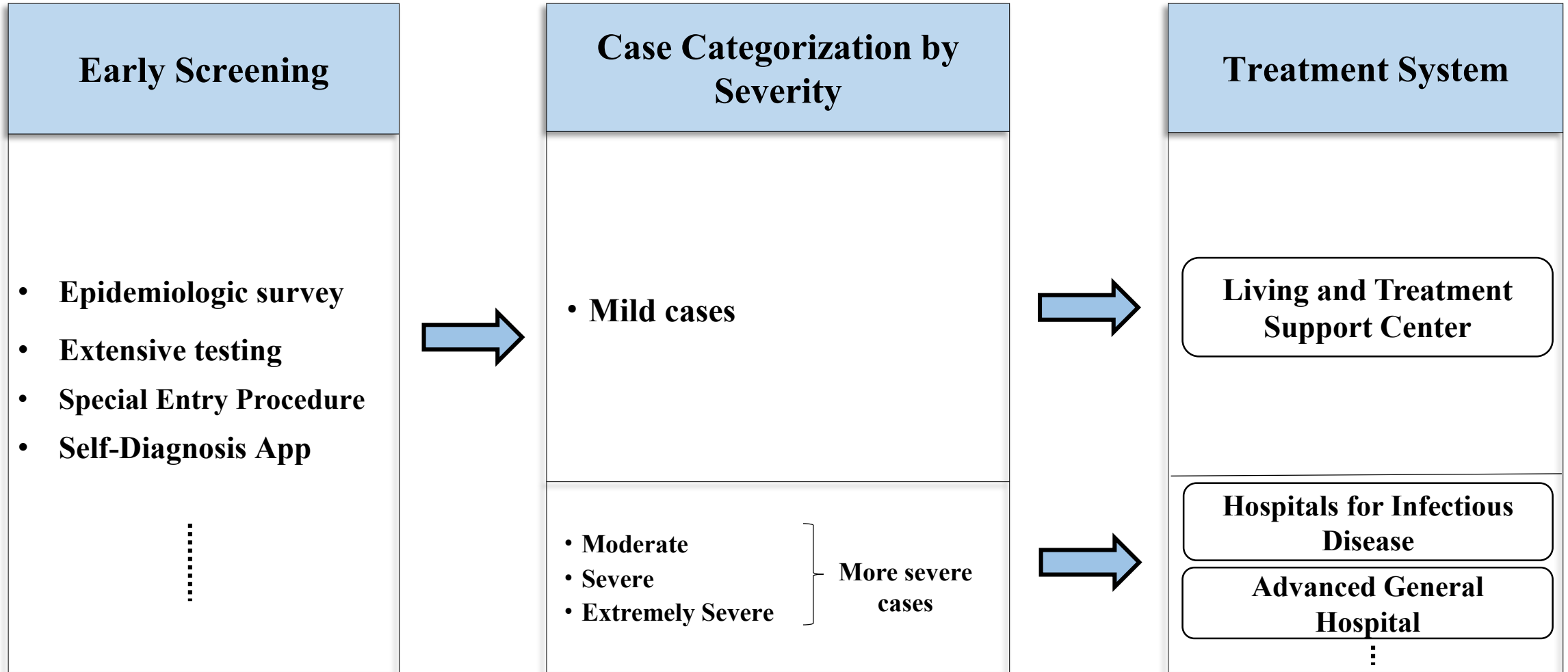

# Principles for COVID-19 Response

## 1. Public participation based on openness and transparency

- Provide information in a transparent and timely manner via briefings given twice a day
- The public contributes by following personal hygiene guidelines and participating in physical distancing

## 2. Containment with minimum restrictions on international travel and exchange

- Ensure economic exchange and travel
- Prevent the spread of the virus without affecting international travel through Special Immigration Procedures and prohibition of overseas travel of close contacts for 14 days

## 3. Equal treatment for Korean and foreign nationals

- Both Korean and foreign nationals are provided with testing and treatment without discrimination

## 4. Cooperation of central and local governments & all members of society

- Central government: Overall management of the situation and response
- Local governments: Epidemiological investigation, disinfection, and patient treatment
- Medical personnel: Patient treatment and research
- Citizens: Personal prevention measures

## 5. Efficient and Creative Measures utilizing cutting-edge Technology

- Self-Diagnosis App/Self-Quarantine App
- Drive-thru & Walking Thru stations for fast and safe collection of specimens





